








Access a course

STEP 2. For example, from the Public activities, click on the category English language, and select either vocabulary practice or grammar practice.

















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

STEP 4. Define the start and end date of the course (not mandatory).


OPTION 1 – DEFINE THE START DATE AND ENABLE THE END DATE

Teacher define the start date of the course and the end date of the course, by selecting the day, month year, hour and minutes from the fields. *It is required that to have the Enable box checked.*




OPTION 2 - DEFINE THE START DATE AND DISABLE THE END DATE

Teacher define the start date of the course and click on the checkbox near the field of the Course end date label to disable the end date of the course.



STEP 5. Add a description of the course (not mandatory).



STEP 6. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on the button Save and Display, to save the course.




4. Click on "Interactive content" option to open the H5P templates.

6. Fill in the form of the selected template and click on "Save and display" button to view and test the activity.





Drag and drop template

The Drag and drop template allows authors to create activities where two or more elements are associated to make logical connections. The learners have to drag a text or an image and drop it in the corresponding drop zones.

- Make sure to define from the start the size of the task (Task size from Step 1). If you modify
 afterwards the size, the Drag and Drop zones or other content added in Step 2, will be will be
 repositioned and must be arranged again.
- Always fill in the Alternative text for images to allow screen readers to view the content.
- All the *Drag zones* of text or images must have selected all the *Drop zones*.
- A *Drop zone* must have only one *Drag zone*.
- When defining a **Drop zone** always activate the following options:
 - o This drop zone can contain only one element.
 - o Enable auto-align.
- On Behavioural settings always have activated the option Enable Full Screen, to allow the
 activity to be displayed properly on mobile devices.





Image choice template

The Image choice template allows authors to create question and answer activities where the answers are in the form of an image. Students must click on one or more questions, as defined, to answer to the question.

- If you add an image in the question section as well, make sure the image is at a low resolution, no more than 200px.
- Always add alt text for images in the answer section.
- A question can have one or more answers. Activating the correct answer is done by ticking the option Correct, which is in the box for each answer.
- To reduce the size of the images that appear in response, click on the **Behavioral changes** section and select the 16:9 option from the **Aspect ratio** field.





Image pairing template

The Image pairing template allows authors to create pairs of images to be matched. Learners are presented with the unpaired images and have to either use drag and drop or click on the images they think matches.

Tips

• Always fill in the *Alternative text* for images to allow screen readers to view the content.





Flashcards template

The Flashcards template allows authors to create activities for memorizing words, expressions or sentences. The learners have to type a word or expression corresponding to the picture, before turning the card over and revealing the correct answer.

- If you want to offer tips to the learners regarding a question, click on the Tip section and fill in the field Tip text.
- Always have activated the option Require user input before the solution can be viewed.
- If you want the answer provided by the learner to be the same as the one you provided in the template, activate the Case sensitive option.





Find Multiple hotspots

The Find Multiple hotspots template allows authors to create an image-based test where the learner need to find the correct spots on an image by clicking on zone defined as a hotspot.

Tips

- Always fill in the *Hotspot Name*.
- Always specify the number of correct hotspots that need to be found for question completion.

Notice!

In the example provided by ATS the audio file is not part of the H5P template. To add an audio file, you can use the **Description** section of the activity.





Quiz (Question set)

The Quiz template allows authors to create a sequence of various quiz types, including Multiple choice questions; Fill in the blanks; Drag and drop; Mark the words or True/False questions. It allows the learner to solve different types of quizzes in a single flow.

- The template for creating Drag and Drop questions is the same as the one explained above.

Course presentation template

The Course presentation template allows authors to create digital activities that have the structure of a PowerPoint presentation. Through this template teachers or content creators can create teaching, assessment or combined activities, storytelling activities, add audio files or videos to create more interactive activities.



In the case of activities that also include the assessment part, the student must go through the narrative part/instructions/text that appears in each slide and respond according to the specifics of each assessment activity (e.g. click on a text/image, drag and drop the text/image in the correct space, write).

- Other options for adding text, interactive elements or other assessment activities, can be found by accessing the icon
- You can duplicate the layout/arrangement of elements of a slide by using the Clone slide option icon
 .





Interactive video Template

The Interactive video template allows authors to create digital activities that have a video attached. Through this template, combined teaching-assessment activities can be created that allow the student to dynamically interact with the presented video.



In these activities, students have to listen and watch the video and according to the set sequences, they need to answer to the assessment activities (e.g. click on a text/image, drag and drop the text/image in the correct space, write).

- From the menu bar you can add in the video assessment activities such as: single choice, multiple choice, true/false questions, fill in the blanks, drag & drop or summary activities.
- Other options for adding text, interactive elements or other assessment activities, can be found by accessing the icon
- It is important to set the display time of the button of the assessment activity, according to the specifics of the sequence in the video that you want to evaluate. Example: At minute 2:05 there is a sequence with a cat and you want the student to answer which animal he/she saw. When you add the rating button to the selected video sequence, the start date is automatically set in the first box of the *Display time* field. You only need to manually add the end date, in the second field to disable the button. The button is usually set to disappear before moving to another sequence in the video.
